Presentation

The Catalan Association of Public Universities (ACUP) was created in 2002 on an initiative of the Universitat de Barcelona (UB), Universitat Autònoma de Barcelona (UAB), Universitat Politècnica de Catalunya (UPC), Universitat Pompeu Fabra (UPF), Universitat de Girona (UdG), Universitat de Lieida (UdL), Universitat Rovira i Virgili (URV) and the Universitat Oberta de Catalunya (UOC). The ACUP's main purpose is to be the principal voice of the universities of Catalonia and combine efforts to promote initiatives, programmes and joint projects with the aim of improving the university system and ensuring that it spearheads social, cultural and economic development.

The preamble of the ACUP Statute reads: "Autonomy, Catalan identity and modernity were the three recurring themes of the Catalan University Congresses held between 1903 and 1918.

These intellectual ideals and aspirations cannot be considered exhausted, they are the driving force behind the public universities' desire to work together. This autonomy to work and be responsible is leading universities to come together to develop joint strategies, for the good of Catalonia. Supplied with a deep knowledge of university history in Catalonia, and recalling the words of *Tirant lo Blanc* [one of the best known medieval works of Catalan literature, XV century] "he who forgets the past, forgets himself", the universities are looking to work for the future. The fact that public universities created an association is an indication of their willingness to work together with one voice in all matters where unanimity is possible. Moreover, a partnership between the universities and the Administration will help to further the cultural progress of

The 2016 Global Education Monitoring (GEM) Report, Education for people and planet: Creating sustainable futures for all, UNESCO, is now available.

The GEM Report, which builds on the experience of the previous EFA Global Monitoring Report (GMR) series, received a new mandate to assess the progress of education under the 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development.

The 2016 Report, the first of a new 15-year series, shows that the world risks achieving its key global education commitments half a century lake, having huge consequences for major development outcomes. It warms that education needs to change if we are to reach the 2030 Sustainable Development Agenda.

The youth version of the GEM Report is also available in form of a cartoon.





Sustainability Transformation of Science Systems

The 2016 COPERNICUS Alliance Conference focuses on the sustainability transformation of institutional, national and international science systems. It will reflect on policies and practices that support or hinder researchers and educators of higher education institutions to practice inter- and transdisciplinary approaches of sustainability science.

Sustainability requires new approaches to knowledge and education. Universities must take on a key role in contributing to a transformation towards sustainable development. This transformation requires an interdisciplinary, transdisciplinary and holistic collaboration at the interface of education, research, policy and practice. The concept of sustainability science has been recognized by UNESCO in its medium-term strategy (2014-2021) as an integrated, problem-solving approach to science and engineering for sustainable development.

In order to walk the talk, the two day conference will - in addition to a few invited keynotes - provide a variety of participative opportunities, such as a "poster walk and talk", parallel interactive sessions fully designed by participants, and a screening of short-videos of contributors who cannot attend in person. A digital conference handbook will provide a guide to the posters and interactive sessions. After the conference, participants will have the chance to submit full papers with findings from their discussions and research to parthering indexed journals.


