Accomodation

There are several hotels in Graz that are situated close to the university campus and the city centre. We can recommend *Hotel Mariahilf**** in the historic city centre. It offers prices from EUR 40.00 (double room per person, incl. breakfast) to 55.00 EUR (single room, incl. breakfast) and is within a distance of a 15-minutes-walk from university. Public transport in Graz

There are different tickets for public transport in Graz:

1-hour ticket: EUR 1,90 24-hour ticket: EUR 4,10 1-week ticket: EUR 10,60

The tickets are valid for bus and tram and have to be **stamped** in the vehicle where they can also be bought.

Going from the station to your hotel:

In front of the station there are several bus and tram stops. Take tram 3 (direction 'Krenngasse') or 6 (direction 'St. Peter') and go to 'Südtirolerplatz/Kunsthaus'. Behind the building 'Kunsthaus' is Hotel Mariahilf (60 m).

A taxi from the station to your hotel will cost about EUR 5.00.

Going from the airport to your hotel:

- 1. Take bus 630 or 631 to 'Jakominiplatz'.
- 2. Take tram 1 (dir. 'Eggenberg/UKH'), 3 (dir. 'Hauptbahnhof'), 6 (dir. 'Hauptbahnhof'), 7 (dir. 'Wetzelsdorf') to 'Südtirolerplatz/Kunsthaus'. Hotels are close by (see above).

A taxi from the airport to your hotel will cost about EUR 18.00.

Going from your hotel to university:

Starting at Hotel Mariahilf:

- 1. Walk to Lendplatz (5 min)
- 2. Take bus 58 direction 'Mariagrün' and go to 'Mozartgasse'.
 Or Take bus 63 (direction 'Petersbergenstraße') or 63A (direction 'Raaba/ÖBB') and go to 'Universität'

A taxi from your hotel to university will cost about EUR 7.00.
